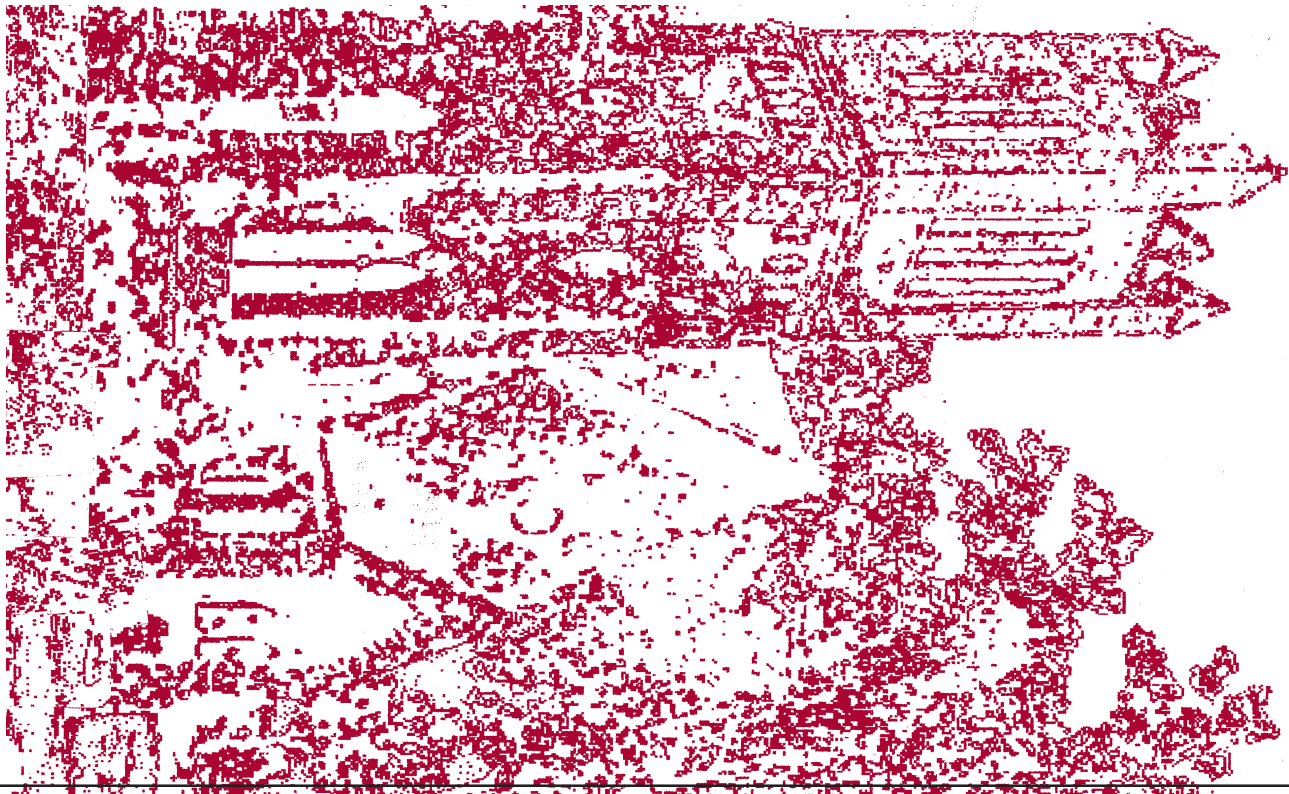

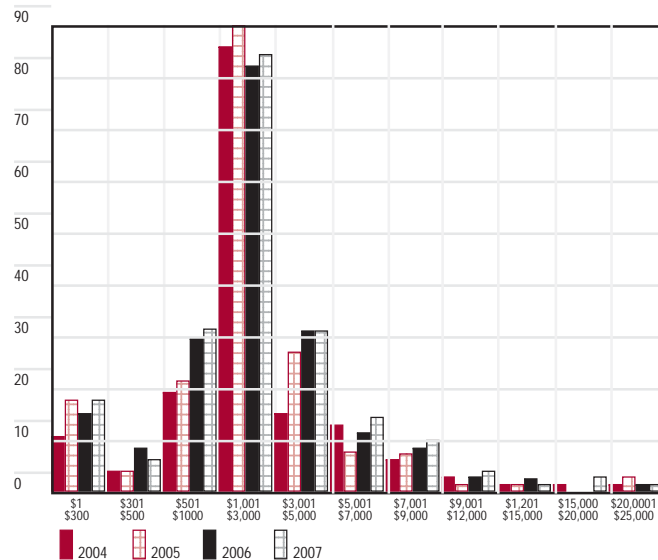
St. Peter's: *Parish Missions and Programs for 2008.*

The outline and explanation of St. Peter's Missions and Programs are contained in the pamphlet mailed to the parish as part of the Stewardship of Talent Campaign in March.

Of immediate focus for St. Peter's is the increase of young families and young children in our parish family. They are indeed our future and a primary direction for the 2008 Stewardship of Treasure Campaign. We are very blessed to have the Reverend Greg Tallant and his family become a part of St. Peter's life. One of Greg's focuses will be to incorporate new families and teenagers into the congregational life of St. Peter's. This focus on new families and teenagers is an additional increase in St. Peter's annual budget and will require additional resources.
