What is Vocare?

“Vocare” is a Latin verb meaning “to call”. Vocare is a renewal weekend geared towards young adults ages 19-30. This is a time of life for asking serious questions, such as:

- Will my life be self-centered, work and career centered, or God centered?
- Which of these will be the most important and how will I keep them all going at the same time?
- How will I create a balance that will allow me to live in harmony with creation and God?
- Christians are called to grow throughout their life, loving God with all of their heart, soul and mind. How are we going to gain the skills to answer Christ’s call?

We hope to answer these questions and more during the weekend!!

Can I attend Vocare?

Any person who is aged 19-30 can attend Vocare. The total cost of the weekend is \$100.00, which is due with the registration form. Each person makes a commitment to be at the beginning of the weekend (6:00 pm on Friday, February 1st) for registration and dinner and to remain for the complete experience (5:00 pm on Sunday, February 3rd). You may invite family and friends to the closing service on Sunday at 3:00 pm.

What to expect at a Vocare Weekend?

A Vocare weekend is staffed by young adults and a few clergy. This team prepares for the weekend by working and praying together. In their planning sessions, they design a series of talks and discussions, which will hopefully help us to become more aware of our being “called by God” and to help each other in answering this call. These talks will focus on subjects such as: spiritual growth, faith, vocation, community and prayer.

In addition to the talks and discussion, we will pray, eat, sing and play together. There will also be opportunities for personal reflection and speaking with the spiritual directors. During the weekend you are encouraged to ask questions, speak up, laugh and enjoy the presence of God in our midst.

When and Where?

The Vocare weekend will be held at Camp Mikell in Toccoa, Ga. starting at 6:00 pm on Friday, February 1st and will end at 5:00 pm on Sunday, February 3rd. There will be a closing service at 3:00 pm on Sunday—you are welcome to invite family and friends.
